Becoming a Voice for Life Volunteer

Christian Voices for Life needs volunteers to partner with us in educating our community on life issues:

Voice for Life volunteers. There are two important ways that Voice for Life volunteers can educate:

1. By every-day conversations with friends, family members, neighbors, or co-workers – any one we come in contact with.
2. By staffing a pro-life display at a booth or table at a public event, such as the Fort Bend County Fair, the Needville Harvest Festival, or other venues. We want to avail ourselves of as many of these opportunities as possible to present important information on life topics to the public.

“Voice for Life” volunteers are volunteers who have educated themselves on life topics, and can confidently explain and present the truth about abortion, contraception and other life topics to other members of the community. Voice for Life booth volunteers are specifically willing to represent Christian Voices for Life at tables and booths at public events.
