#### **Education:**

On the order of 30% of abortions are chosen because of economic reasons.<sup>1</sup> Whether it is a married couple or a single mother already struggling to provide for children already born, adding the burden of medical bills, long term responsibility for another child, and perhaps loss of income, may seem to be too much to bear. "Preventing" the arrival of another child by means of abortion may seem to be the only reasonable and even responsible choice.
