This week's Topic: Life Chain Oct 2, 2011



Education: Life Chain is a peaceful and prayerful public statement against abortion. It began in California in 1987 and in 2010 was held in over 1700 locations in over 1500 cities and towns in the U.S. and Canada. On the first Sunday of October, participants stand along a busy highway with signs that proclaim "Abortion Kills Children", "Abortion Hurts Women", "Jesus Forgives and Heals", "Adoption a Loving Option", "Lord, Forgive Our Nation" and a few other messages. These messages are not voiced in the mainstream media, so Christians act as the light of Christ to proclaim them to the community on the

highway. We will never know how many abortions may be prevented by this simply reminder of the truth. The web site www.LifeChain.net lists locations by state and city. Local locations in and near Fort Bend county including Hwy 90A in Rosenberg, Hwy 6 in Sugar Land/Missouri City, So. Mason Rd in Katy, and Beltway 8 near Airport.
