The Walls are Talking - Have You Heard Them?

Education: Susan Thayer was a Planned Parenthood (PP) manager for 17 years in Iowa. Shelley Guillory was a nurse at an abortion clinic in Louisiana. Monica Leal Cline was a Health Educator for PP in Texas and New Mexico. Annette Lancaster was a PP Manager in North Carolina. These four women join together to expose the practices of abortion clinics in a 3 minute video "[Exposing the Industry](#)". They connected with each other through [And Then There Were None](#), a ministry founded by Abby Johnson, also a former Planned Parenthood manager, to encourage and help other workers to leave the abortion industry. The women talk


about the tactics used to sell abortions, the lack of meaningful counseling about adoption, and the desire to exclude parents as "a barrier to service". Women who come looking for real help to make a difficult decision are sold a product, even pressured to decide for abortion. The clinics are clearly more interested in making money than actually helping women.

We should listen to those who know – who have seen from inside the industry what really goes on. Hopefully their public testimonies will encourage others to leave as well.
