The Abortion Industry Does NOT Speak for Me!



Education: Last week, we wrote about the upcoming decision in the Supreme Court regarding a Louisiana law requiring abortion clinics to have doctors with hospital admitting privileges.(1) In fact, every other outpatient surgery in Louisiana must be done by a doctor with hospital privileges, so why should abortion be the exception? (2) The Louisiana law passed with virtually no opposition, so who was challenging it in a

federal court? June Medical Services, an abortion provider, claiming to act on behalf of its clients. But how can the industry who is endangering its clients claim to sue on behalf of the women who need the protection against the industry's practices?

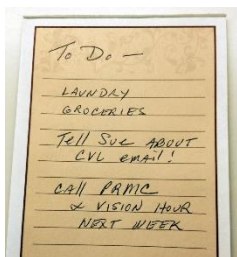
Alveda King and Cynthia Collins (shown above) wrote an article stating clearly that the abortion industry doesn't speak for them. Both women were harmed by their own abortions and now work in the pro-life movement. Cynthia Collins works with Operation Outcry, which collected 4,000 testimonies from women injured by abortion, which were given to the Supreme Court as part of its Amicus Brief in support of the Louisiana law.(3)

An ob/gyn who had worked on many women who came to emergency rooms after an abortion was frustrated by the time lost in going through assessments and the inability to contact the abortionist to get the information he needed to give the best care. No other medical speciality allows patients to be abandoned to ER care by doctors with no information about the preceding events and medications.(2)
