This week's Topic: Market for Fetal Body Parts



Education: The sale of human parts is illegal. However, after the decision is made to have an abortion, women may be asked to donate the fetal tissue to be used for research. The way it works is this: the company in the business of providing fetal body parts rents space in the abortion facility. Although technically not “selling” the tissues, they charge researchers a fee for obtaining, preparing, and delivering the body parts. It is a money-making business for the company and an extra income stream for the abortion facility. ABC did a segment on 20/20 on the market for fetal body parts on March 8, 2000, citing a price list of parts from a firm called Opening Lines, with prices in the hundreds of dollars for each organ. Immediately afterward, a Congressional hearing investigated. The investigation that triggered these events was done by [Life Dynamics, Inc.](http://www.lifedynamics.com) In the 2007 update to the original report, Life Dynamics asserts that trafficking in fetal body parts definitely continues today.(1)

Some may argue that if children are going to die by abortion anyway, there is no reason not to make use of their organs to benefit others. However, donating organs to science may make some women feel that the abortion is doing some good and is therefore justified. And of course the additional profit from fetal tissue gives the abortion facility even more motivation to sell abortions – encouraging what is best for them, rather than what is best for the mother. The recipients of the organs are also motivated to continue to allow legal abortion in order to maintain their supply.

Action: Contact the National Institutes of Health Office of Extramural Research Communications Office at oeer@od.nih.gov or 301-435-0714. Tell the NIH that you think it is wrong to use taxpayer money to allow researchers to buy fetal body parts from aborted babies. Increasing the profit from abortion will tend to increase efforts to sell or coerce abortion. No amount of benefit from research will balance the evil of taking the life of a pre-born child, and their tissues should not be treated as commodities.
