Medical Associations Falsely Attack Pregnancy Centers



Education: Pregnancy help centers care about women in unplanned pregnancies. They listen without judgment, and then offer information and support to empower women to choose life for their child. They provide free ultrasounds and material resources such as diapers and baby items, as well as parenting classes and referrals to community resources. All this help for women to choose life is of course causing the abortion industry to lose money. And so they fight back, making false claims against pregnancy centers.

Recently, however, an attack has come in a medical journal. The Society for Adolescent Health and Medicine (AHM) and the North American Society for Pediatric and Adolescent Gynecology (NASPAG) recently published a position paper in which they state that “Crisis pregnancy centers attempt to dissuade pregnant people from considering abortion, often using misinformation and unethical practices.” Several authors of the paper have strong ties to abortion activism. 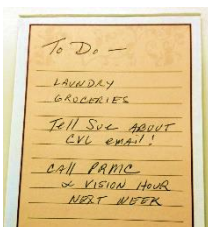
The paper states that crisis pregnancy centers (CPCs) fail “to adhere to ethical practice standards”. False: Pregnancy centers adhere to a national code of ethics called “Our Commitment of Care and Competence”. Multiple investigations and court decisions have confirmed that pregnancy centers are truthful and honest. Another statement says that CPCs should be held to established standards of medical care. They are, since medical services at pregnancy help medical clinics are overseen by licensed medical professionals who are held to the same standards as others in their state.(1)
