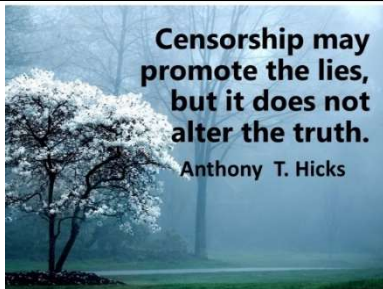




Why isn't Abortion Pill Reversal in the News?



Education: Ashley was just out of high school. She was pregnant and frightened. The baby's father urged her to have an abortion. She didn't want to, but eventually made an appointment for a chemical abortion. After taking the pill, she immediately had regrets. Fortunately, she found the Abortion Pill Rescue (APR) Network, and was able to save her baby. (1) But how many women with immediate regrets do not find the APR Network? Why has no one heard of APR?

The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) has chosen politics over science. An article on the ACOG website stated "So-called abortion 'reversal' procedures are unproven and unethical." (2) The Associated Press stylebook is a premier writing and editing reference for newsrooms. The 56th edition (2022 – 2024) repeated the position of ACOG, advising writers to avoid giving credence to the abortion pill reversal process. (3) The "choice" to reverse their abortion is being hidden from women. Thankfully, the 57th edition of the Stylebook, published in 2024, did NOT include the biased statements. (4)

The truth about APR is stated by the American Association of Pro-Life Obstetricians and Gynecologists (AAPLOG): [APR] is...based on basic pharmacokinetic principles and the existing literature shows that it is safe and effective." (5) Heartbeat International has undeniable evidence that the procedure has a 66% success rate if begun within 3 days. Over 6,000 babies alive and well today because of APR. (6)
