And Then There Were None



Education: What would happen if abortion clinics couldn't find workers to staff their centers? Abortions are not done by anonymous machines, they are done by people. Some in the industry may be very hardened by years of killing children or by their involvement. But many workers at abortion clinics are not particularly happy in their jobs. Some may have answered an ad for a job as a receptionist or bookkeeper without realizing the nature of the business. Only after they have been working there a while, telling themselves they are not directly involved, are they told they need to take a turn at working in the lab. Some are women who have had abortions themselves, and seeing others make the same choice, and even encouraging them to do so, helps them to deny their guilt. Some women hate their jobs but see no other way to feed their families.

How many might leave their jobs if given encouragement and financial help to make a transition to a different job? Abby Johnson, a former Planned Parenthood “Employee of the Year” left her job with PP and founded an organization, *And Then There Were None*, to help abortion workers leave the industry. She has also organized a special retreat experience to help those who have left to heal from the trauma of their close involvement with the killing business of abortion. Planned Parenthood actually helped them to reach more people by issuing a “warning” to their employees, apparently to discourage them from contacting them. However, the warning served to inform employees of the existence of the organization – and several contacted them for help to leave their jobs!



Prayer: Dear Father God, please rain down your grace on all who work in the abortion industry. Please, Lord, remove from their hearts and minds any misconceptions they may have that abortion helps women, or that the child is not a fully human child of God, worthy of respect. Help them to place their trust in You and leave their jobs. Help them to learn of the help available from *And Then There Were None*. Lead them to healing and peace in a closer relationship with You, dear Lord.

May abortion clinics close for lack of employees to participate in all the services necessary to run any facility. When companies and individuals are asked to serve the needs of abortion clinics – whether it be with plumbing, electrical services, advertising, or whatever – give them the grace to refuse to involve themselves or give any support to those who pretend that the killing of children in the womb is a legitimate business.



Action: Please pray, for all who work in the abortion industry. Pray that they will repent of their involvement and have the courage to leave their jobs. Pray that *And Then There Were None* will be enabled to reach many employees and help them to find healing and peace as well as new jobs.
